NEW FIRE HOUSE NEEDS

The local Glen Haven Firehouse has served the community well for many years, but with the ever-increasing demand for equipment, services, and training, the time has come to build a new firehouse.

- Service area includes approximately 25,000 acres which is heavily wooded and at high risk for fire danger.
- Approximately 600 families included in the service area.
- Responds to about 6 wildfires per year.
- The department averages approximately 50 calls per year and about 70% of those calls are medical in nature.
- The 2010 average response time was an amazing 6 minutes.
- There are mutual aid agreements with Estes Valley Fire Protection District, Loveland Rural Fire Protection District, Allenspark FD, Big Elk Meadows FD, and Pinewood Springs FD.
- The present firefighting force consists of 18 members, including 3 certified EMT's.
